ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE BUILDER WHAT YOU NEED: BIBLE, MEMORY VERSE

What You Do:

Review the Memory Verse with your kids by playing a fun game of complete the verse! Here's what you'll do:

- Read Colossians 3:13
- Then write the following parts of the verse down on paper. Then divide the pieces of paper and scramble them up for kids to put in order from memory:
 - "Put up with one another."
 - "Forgive one another,"
 - "If you are holding something against someone."
 - "Forgive just as the Lord forgave you."
 - "Colossians 3:13"

Check if verse was placed in order and review with your children.

ACTIVITY: TIC-TAC-TOE TOURNAMENT

Have family members join in to play giant tic-tac-toe. Using objects from around the house, (brooms, towels, shoes, etc.) create a large tic-tac-toe board.

Have 2 people compete against each other. The winning person can pick who they would like to challenge next.



BIBLE STORY REVIEW: WHAT YOU NEED: BIBLE

What You Say:

Let's review the story from this week's lesson. It is found in

Luke 15:21-32 Let's read it again.

"I can relate to the older brother in this story. He's right; he was the one who had stayed, the one who worked hard and honored his dad. But he missed out. Because he thought it was more important to be right than to forgive, he missed the opportunity to celebrate his brother's return. Sometimes we do the same thing. We want to make a point or prove that we're right and the other person is wrong. But in the end, your friendship is WAY more important than winning an argument. We need to offer forgiveness when someone apologizes and means it. Because when you don't forgive, you miss out."

PRAYER

"God, Thank You for Your forgiveness and Your love. We want to show others Your love! God, please give us Your power and Your strength to forgive others. Help us to let go of anything we may be holding against others so we don't miss out on the joy of Your forgiveness. Amen!"
