ACTIVITY: CREATE

WHAT YOU NEED: VARIOUS CRAFT SUPPLIES: YARN, CRAFT STICKS, COTTON BALLS, BUTTONS, PIPE CLEANERS

DURING THE ACTIVITY:

Ask the children to select craft items and use their imaginations to create something. The creations will be free play, not glued down or saved.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY:

Give the children time to share what they made.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BFLOKE:

Come sit with me. I gathered lots of supplies for you. I want you to use your imagination to create something with these supplies. I can't wait to see what you create!

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Wow! Look at all the beautiful things you've made! (Give the children time to share their creations.) What amazing creativity! Great job, friends. In today's story, we'll learn that God is so powerful that He created all of us! Let's go.



ACTIVITY: BIBLE STORY REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: PROPEL JR ONLINE, BIBLE (PSALM 147:5) WHAT YOU DO:

Let's sit down and talk about today's Bible story. Our Bible story was about how God is SO powerful that He made everything out of nothing!

God made beautiful flowers that smell like perfume, apple trees and berry bushes that give us yummy food, HUGE oceans with whales and fish swimming around, the warm sun, and all of the twinkling stars! Then God made His favorite . . . PEOPLE! God made you, and God made me! Wow! God is powerful!

And I have the perfect Bible verse for us to learn to help us remember that God is powerful. It says . . . 'Great is our Lord and mighty in power,' Psalm 147:5.

Let's stand up and say this together with these motions.

"Great(jazzhands) is our Lord (pointup) and mighty in power," (fistsonhips) Psalm 147:5." (Open hands like a book.)

(Repeat the verse with motions a few times.)

You sound great! (Give two thumbs-up.) Every time I ask, 'Who is powerful?', I want you to say, 'God is powerful.' Let me hear you. Who is powerful?"

When I say your name, tell me one thing God made. This is such a good list! Let's use it when we pray. Let's pray.

PRAYER

Dear God, thank You for making such a wonderful world filled with so many wonderful things. Help us remember how powerful You are every time we see a (read the list the children made). God, thank You for making (say each child's name). I hope they always know how special they are because You made them. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen.
